

10-Day Evangelical Pilgrimage Tour

Notes:

>> SETI's Evangelical Pilgrimages pair archaeological exploration with inspirational Bible teaching. These tours cover sites important to the Christian and Jewish faiths. You can schedule outdoor worship services, take time for prayer and Bible reading, and much more! You can also add two or three days to your tour, and visit Egypt or Jordan!

>> For pilgrimage tours, SETI offers a variety of guiding options. A pastoral guide can show you the sites from a devotional and Biblical perspective, or an archaeological guide can teach you about the history behind the Bible. These tours can be customized to suit any denomination, and guides can split time with the group's leader or pastor.

Day 1

Tour Schedule: Arrival & Welcome Banquet

Arrive in Tel Aviv, and travel to Galilee to check in to the hotel. Welcome and orientation.

Day 2

The Sea of Galilee

Start the day by visiting Capernaum, the town of Jesus. Take a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee to Ginosaur for lunch. After lunch tour the Ancient Boat Museum and the Jordan River.

Day 3

Northern Galilee

Begin with prayer time on the Mount of Beatitudes. Travel to Caesarea Philippi, where Peter made his great confession. Next, discover the ruins of Dan, and have a relaxing evening visiting the Hot Springs

Day 4

Nazareth & Beit Shean

In the morning, visit Mt. Precipice overlooking the field of Armageddon. Explore the cities of Nazareth and Tzipori. End in Beit Shean, the capital of the Decapolis where King Saul and Jonathan were killed.

Day 5

Mount Carmel & Caesarea

Head west to enjoy the view from Mt. Carmel. Later, discover the theatre, aqueduct, and other ruins of Caesarea Maritima on the shore of the Mediterranean Sea. Drive to Jerusalem to check in to hotel.

Day 6

Jerusalem & Bethlehem

Open with an introduction to Jerusalem from the Mt of Olives. Have communion at the Garden of Gethsemane. Afterwards, tour the Israeli Museum and the Church of the Nativity in Bethlehem.

Day 7

The Old City of Jerusalem

Tour the Western Wall, the Temple Mount, and the Archaeological Park. In the afternoon, visit the Holy Sepulcher, before having a prayer and worship service in the Garden Tomb.

Day 8

Masada & The Dead Sea

Discover Jericho, the "City of Palms," then take a dip in the Dead Sea. See Qumran, where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found. Have the option to stay on the beach or tour the desert fortress of Masada.

Day 9

City of David & Tower of David

Back in Jerusalem, explore the City of David, the oldest part of Jerusalem. Includes Hezekiah's Tunnel and the Pool of Siloam. After lunch, tour the Tour of David at Jaffa Gate.

Day 10

Final Day in Jerusalem

Shop the markets, and enjoy free time to visit any additional sites. Finally, check out of the hotel and depart to the airport in Tel Aviv.
